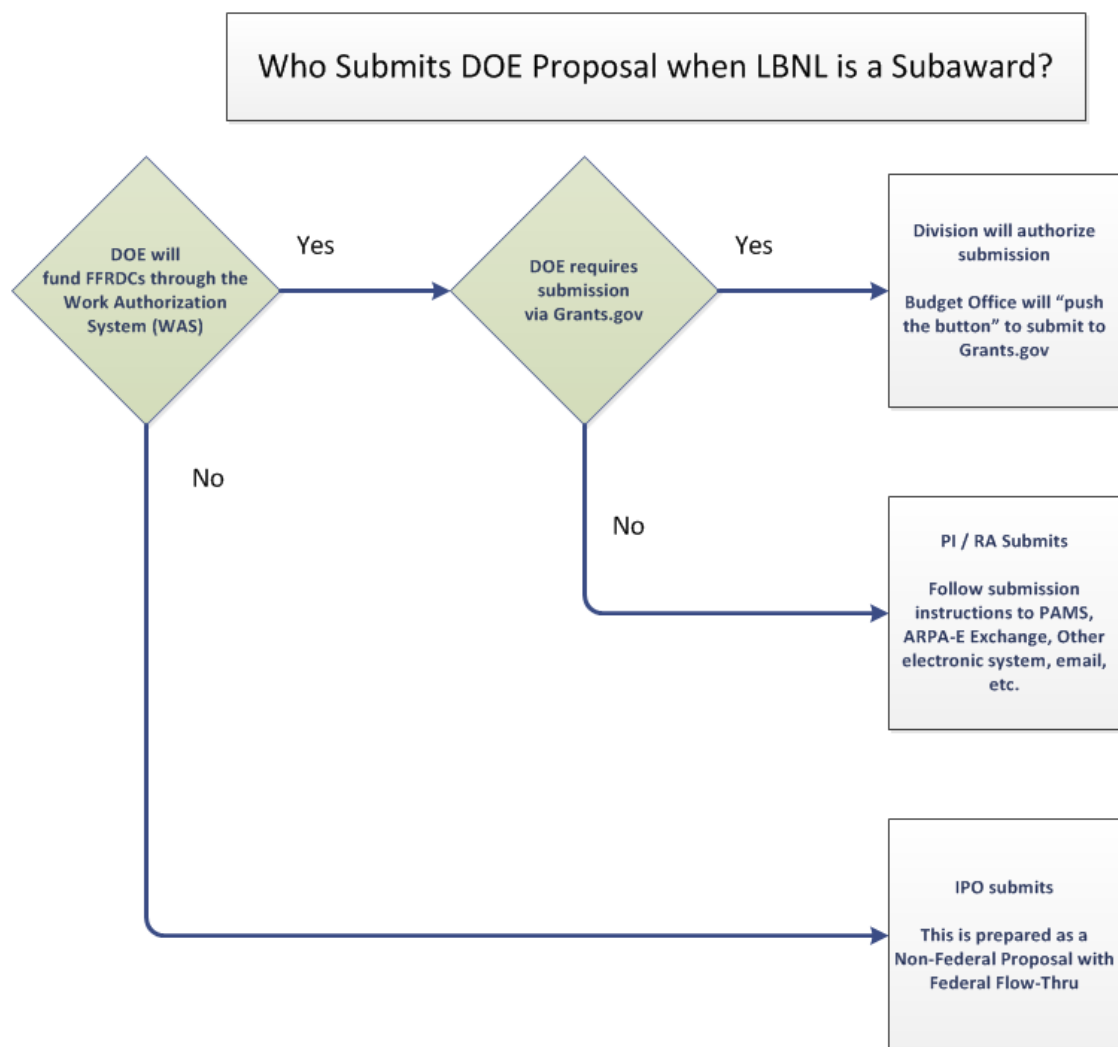


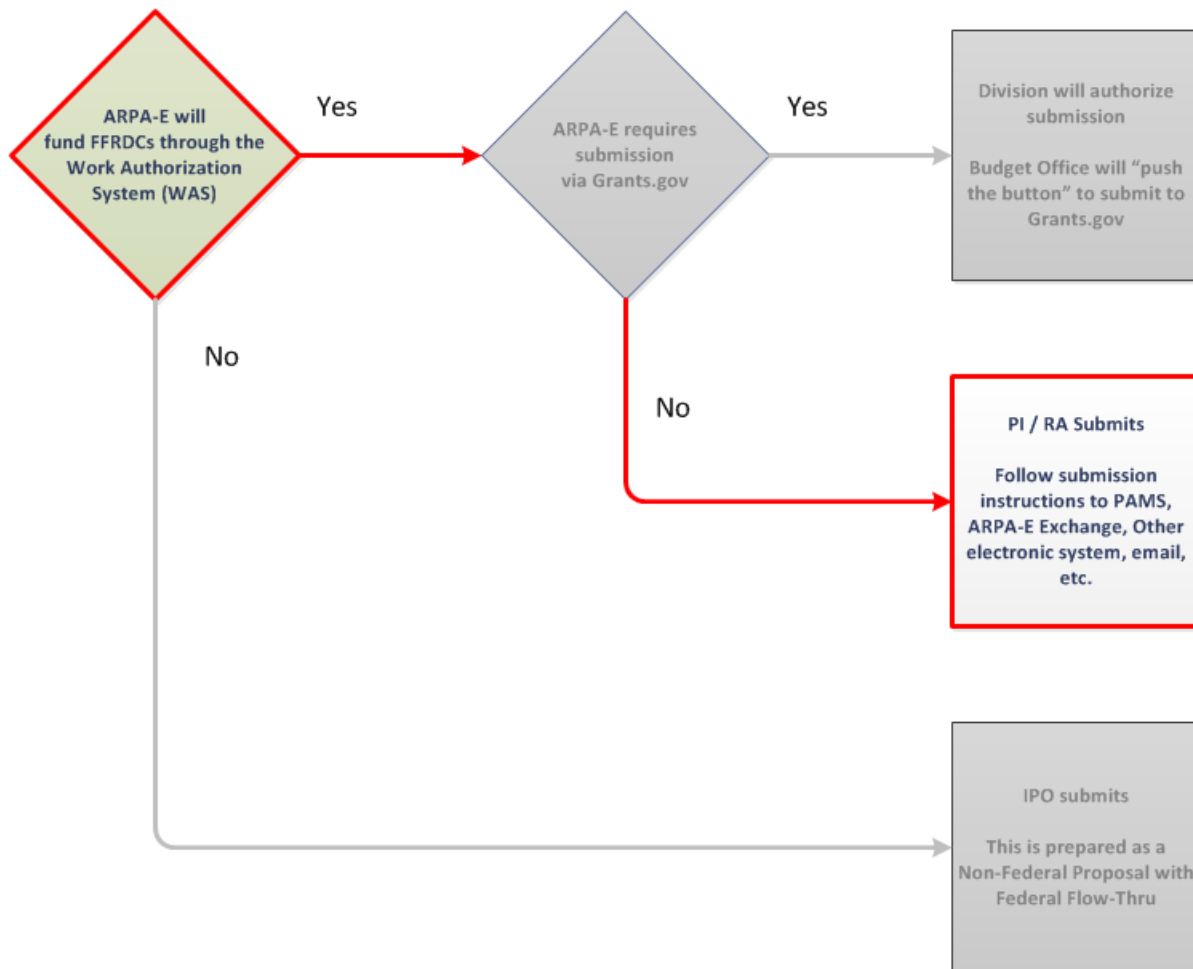
Divisions have the delegated authority to submit proposals directly to DOE. Contract Officers in the IPO and the Budget Office Reimbursable Group have the delegation to submit proposals to non-DOE entities. Therefore, when we submit directly to DOE the proposal must be submitted by the division. In the case of a Grants.gov submission, the division will still authorize the submission, but Sophia Marneris in the Budget Office will push the button to send it to Grants.gov.

What about proposals going to DOE where the Berkeley Lab is a subaward?

If the Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) indicates funding to DOE Labs or FFRDCs will come through the Work Authorization Statement (WAS), the delegation to submit those proposals lies with the division. If the FOA is silent on this point, the proposal will be submitted as a non-federal flow-thru proposal by the IPO Contract Officer. If this guidance does not provide clear direction, send a copy of the FOA to eSRHelp@lbl.gov. The help desk will consult where necessary and provide you with an answer.
